EMERGENCY ORDER

WHEREAS, a State of Emergency has been declared by the County of Fulton; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County is experiencing prolonged dry weather conditions, resulting in extremely dry vegetation and environmental conditions that are susceptible to fire; and

WHEREAS, due to the lack of rain and extremely dry conditions an Emergency Order of a No Burn Order has been issued for the County of Fulton; including burn barrels and outside fireplaces throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fulton is responsible for securing the health and safety of its residents and such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the citizens of Fulton County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John H. Blackmon, as Chairman of the Fulton County Board of Supervisors, in accordance with New York State Executive Law, Chapter 18, Article 2-B, effective from 12:00 p.m. on November 1, 2024, and continuing until I declare the State of Emergency no longer necessary or until it expires by law—whichever occurs first—to safeguard public safety and ensure the provision of essential assistance for the security, health, and well-being of Fulton County residents, hereby direct all County departments and agencies to take all necessary measures to protect lives, property, public infrastructure, and provide any needed emergency assistance by declaring a State of Emergency.
